STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS OF M&D EUROPE (UK) LIMITED (“Terms & Conditions”)

1. Background

These are the Terms & Conditions under which M & D Europe (UK) Limited (“M & D”) agree to assist the Student in seeking to gain acceptance to a Course at an educational institution which may be based in the UK or overseas, or leading to a place at a Medical or Dental school which may be at a University based in the UK or at a University based overseas.

2. Definitions and Interpretation

2.1 The following terms shall have the following meanings for the purposes of this agreement:

- 2.1.1 ‘Admission Date’ means the date set by the University at which the Student is accepted on a Course in an official letter of acceptance;
- 2.1.2 ‘Application Form’ means an original M&D application form;
- 2.1.3 ‘Commencement Date’ means the date specified on page 2 of the Application Form, beside signatures;
- 2.1.4 ‘Course’ means a Medical or Dental degree course or Pre-Medical Programme at a UK or overseas University or educational institution as represented by M&D;
- 2.1.5 ‘Final Payment’ means the final payment/instalment of the amounts payable under the Payments to M&D;
- 2.1.6 ‘Guarantor’ means the guarantor as stated in the Application Form;
- 2.1.7 ‘Payments’ means the amounts listed in Schedule 1;
- 2.1.8 ‘Services’ means those services specifically set out at clause 4.1;
- 2.1.9 ‘Student’ means an individual that has fully completed and submitted an official M&D Application Form to apply for a Course;
- 2.1.10 ‘Term’ means from the Commencement Date until the date of the Final Payment;
- 2.1.11 ‘University’ means a university or educational institution based in the UK or overseas providing any particular Course as determined by M&D.

3. Appointment

The Student appoints M & D to carry out the Services as described at clause 4.1 for the Term in return for the Payments.

4. M & D’s Obligations

4.1 Services to be provided by M & D

On the understanding that all payments under the Payments will be made in full to M&D, M&D agree to provide the following services, so far as practicable and according to the Students specific requests;

- 4.1.1 To arrange for an application, and where possible assist and provide guidance in order to maximise the success of any application to a Medical or Dental School at a University either in the UK or overseas. For the avoidance of doubt, M & D cannot guarantee acceptance on any particular Course, however M & D agree to use its skill and knowledge to the best of its ability in arranging for appropriate guidance to be given so that the chance of acceptance is maximised.
- 4.1.2 To prepare and process applications for a Course and to arrange for entrance tests and interviews on behalf of the University or educational institution, where necessary and appropriate. For the avoidance of doubt, M & D have no obligation to the Student to ensure successful exam results throughout any period of education arranged by M & D. Continued success in such exams, modules, dissertations or any other method of assessment is solely related to the discipline, application and ability of the Student. Acceptance or admittance of a Student onto a Course by a University or by M&D is not an indication of expected success on the Course.
- 4.1.3 To provide guidance to the best of its knowledge, where necessary, in obtaining Student Visas for British nationals. Students that are not British are advised to contact their relevant authorities in their home country to seek guidance, as M&D shall not be able to assist in Visa or Immigration matters for non-British Students. All students are advised that the arrangement and processing of their Visa’s is their own responsibility, administered between the Student and the country or Embassy concerned and M&D have no obligation to the Student to ensure completion of relevant Visa requirements, before or during the duration of the Course.
- 4.1.4 To provide general guidance on arranging for University-managed Student accommodation, if available. All arrangements, payments, availability and personal inspections of accommodation are the responsibility of the Student.
- 4.1.5 To provide the Student with general guidance on current tuition fees and living expenses for Courses. M & D will also introduce Banks and Student Loan organisations that the students may wish to consider. M&D have no obligation to the Student for the success or failure of any loan applications made, before, during, or after the Course.
- 4.1.6 To provide general guidance on estimated student living expenses, however the student is advised to gain more specific information from the relevant Embassies or Tourism Offices relevant to their desired destination and location.
- 4.1.7 To provide general guidance on the chances of being accepted onto a course and conditions to be met by The Student before a University will consider or accept an application. Views and opinions offered by M&D are not to be representative or a substitute of a University’s opinion on an application and The Student must seek confirmation on outcome of their application detailed on an official letter from the University they have applied to only.

4.2 Secrecy

Not at any time during or after the Term to divulge or allow to be divulged to any person or make use of any confidential information.

4.3 Disclaimer

M & D is not responsible to the Student for the arrangements of or the making of any payments towards flights, books, housing, travel costs, living expenses or any form of insurance. Students are advised to seek advice on all necessary travel or health insurance prior to starting the Course. M & D cannot be held responsible for any changes in policy, tuition fees, recognition or status on the University or educational institution after enrolment, and M&D will not be liable for any losses incurred by Students as a result of any such changes.

Students are advised to confirm in advance with the relevant degree recognising authorities in their home country and with the World Health Organisation in Geneva on the recognition status of the University or Course.

5. The Student’s Obligations

In consideration of the Services to be rendered by M & D under this agreement the Student agrees:

- 5.1 To make the Payments (set out at Schedule 1) promptly, and to understand that failure to do so may result in their application and subsequent enrolment onto the Course being withdrawn;
- 5.2 To supply M & D with such material and information that it requires in order to fulfil its obligations under these Terms & Conditions. Incomplete applications will not be accepted by M&D;
- 5.3 To comply with all obligations required pursuant to any arrangement with any University entered into to the best of their skill and ability. To ensure that all information supplied to M & D is true to the best of their knowledge. Any document or statement found to be falsified may jeopardise the Student’s application, or could lead to the Student’s expulsion from the Course without financial refund of any Payments made or still outstanding to either M & D or the relevant University or educational institution.
- 5.4 To give full permission to M&D and to the University into which they may be admitted, to exchange information about their academic performance, attendance and any disciplinary measures whilst the Student remains on the Course.
- 5.5 That acceptance onto any Course (whatever the relevant academic standard for that particular Course) is entirely at their own risk, and that M & D shall not be responsible for the success of the Student on that particular Course.

6. Payment

- 6.1 In circumstances where M&D consider it necessary in its absolute discretion, M & D reserve the right to conduct credit reference checks related to the Student or Guarantor.
- 6.2 In circumstances where M&D consider it necessary in its absolute discretion the Guarantor (whether of foreign or British nationality) may be required to make upfront and full payment of the Application Form Fee and/or the relevant Administration Fee as set out in Schedule 1 prior to the Student completing such application for a Course and prior to any Services being provided by M&D.
- 6.3 No Services shall be provided by M&D until it receives in cleared funds in its bank account those monies referred to in clause 6.1 and at least fourteen days prior to enrolment on a Course.

Follow y cancellations.™

- 7.1 After completing the Application Form and prior to enrolment on the Course, where the Student does not subsequently enrol; within three years of initially being admitted; at any of the faculties of any of the Universities set out in Schedule 1, the Student may cancel this agreement with immediate effect by providing notice in writing to M & D to this effect; such notice to be sent by registered mail only to M&D's address at Challenge House in Croydon; as set out on page 2 of the Application Form.
- 7.2 In circumstances other than clause 7.1 (above), the Student may cancel this agreement without any liability other than the initial non-refundable Application Form Fee (as defined at Schedule 1) at any time before the Admission Date. On or after the Admission Date, the Student shall then be liable to pay to M & D the Payments in full as described in Schedule 1.
8. **VAT**
- 8.1 All sums payable under this Agreement are exclusive of any applicable tax, (unless otherwise stated) which will, if required by law, be added to the sum in question.
- 8.2 Any VAT or other duties or taxes payable in respect of such sums shall be payable in addition to such sums.
9. **Liability**
- 9.1 No liability on part of M & D unless M & D in default
M & D shall not be liable to the Student for loss or damage to the Student unless due to the negligence or other failure of M & D to perform its obligations under this agreement or under the general law.
10. **Miscellaneous**
- 10.1 Interest
All sums due from the Student to M & D which are not paid on the due date (without prejudice to the rights of M & D under this agreement) shall bear interest from day to day at the annual rate of 4% over the base lending rate of HSBC Bank plc.
11. **Force Majeure**
Both parties shall be released from their respective obligations in the event of national emergency war prohibitive governmental regulation extreme weather conditions, such as hurricanes, or if any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the parties, or either of them renders the performance of this agreement impossible whereupon all money due under this agreement shall be paid immediately and in particular:
- 11.1 The Student shall immediately pay to M & D all arrears of Payments; and
- 11.2 Each party shall be liable to pay to the other damages for any breach of this agreement and all expenses and costs incurred by that party in enforcing its rights under this agreement.
12. **Severance**
If any provision of this agreement is declared by any judicial or other competent authority to be void voidable illegal or otherwise the remaining provisions of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect unless M & D in M & D's discretion decides that the effect of such declaration is to defeat the original intention of the parties in which event M & D shall be entitled to terminate this agreement by 30 days' notice to the Student.
13. **Whole agreement**
- 13.1 Each party acknowledges that these Terms & Conditions contains the whole agreement between the parties, that it supersedes any prior agreement between the parties, and that it has not relied upon any oral or written representation made to it by the other or its employees or agents and has made its own independent investigations into all matters relevant to it.
- 13.2 The Student acknowledges that any further agreements (of any nature) entered into with the Universities and educational institutions shall be made directly between those parties and shall not create any obligations upon M & D.
14. **Proper law and jurisdiction**
- 14.1 This agreement shall be governed by English law in every particular including formation and interpretation and shall be deemed to have been made in England.
- 14.2 Any proceedings arising out of or in connection with this agreement may be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction in England and Wales.
- 14.3 The submission by the parties to such jurisdiction shall not limit the right of M & D to commence any proceedings arising out of this agreement in any other jurisdiction it may consider appropriate.
15. **Waiver**
The failure by either party to enforce at any time or for any period any one or more of the terms or conditions of this agreement shall not be a waiver of them or of the right at any time subsequently to enforce all terms and conditions of this agreement.
16. **Third party rights**
A person who is not a party to this agreement has no rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any terms of this agreement
17. **Arbitration**
All disputes or differences which at any time arise between the parties whether during the Term or afterwards touching or concerning this agreement or its construction or effect or the rights duties or liabilities of the parties under or by virtue of it or otherwise or any other matter in any way connected with or arising out of the subject matter of this agreement shall be referred to a single arbitrator to be agreed upon by the parties or in default of agreement to be nominated by the President for the time being of the Chartered Institution of Arbitrators in accordance with the Arbitration Act 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment of it for the time being in force.
